



JUNIOR BELGIAN CHAMPIONSHIP 2022-2023

1. TOURNAMENT INFO

- 1.1. The Junior Belgian Padel Championships will be played from 3rd July until 9 of July.
- 1.2. All matches will be played at Tour&Taxis Padel Club.
- 1.3. Categories for the Junior Belgian Championship are: Boys U14, Boys U16, Boys U18 and Girls U14, Girls U16, Girls U18.

- 1.4. Players can only participate in their own age category.

2. TOURNAMENT ORGANISATION

- 2.1. Only players with the Belgian nationality can register.
- 2.2. There is a maximum of 16 registrations per category. In case the number of registrations exceeds the maximum, the team with the lowest sum of the 'klassement'/'classement' (the best 'klassement/classement' of Padel Vlaanderen and AFT Padel will be considered) will be rejected. In case of an ex aequo, toss will decide.
- 2.3. Group stage will be played during the week from 3 PM.
- 2.4. Final draw will be played the weekend from 10 AM.
- 2.5. Players need to be fully available.
- 2.6. The availabilities required of your age category will be shown at sign in on www.aftpadel.be
- 2.7. Teams need to register by pair through the system of the organizing federation (www.aftpadel.be).
- 2.8. Players can also sign in individually by sending a mail at the following address : celine.guissard@aftnet.be. Federation in cooperation with the junior national coaches will try to make the "best" teams possible.

3. DRAW

- 3.1. A group stage + an elimination tournament draw will be used. In case of 16 participating pairs, there will be 4 groups of 4 teams.
- 3.2. Every 4 teams registered, there will be one seed added.
- 3.3. In case there is less than 6 teams registered, a group with all the teams registered will be used as the final draw. The winner of the group will be the winner and the second of the group the finalist.
- 3.4. The 4 seeds (1 in each group) will be determined based on the best sum of "klassement/classement" of both players (dd 26/6/2023). In case of an ex aequo, toss will decide.

- 3.5. All ¼ finals will be played on Saturday and all semi-finals and finals will be played on Sunday.
- 3.6. All matches are played without referee.
- 3.7. All matches are played to two winning sets and a match tie-break in case of a third set.
- 3.8. From quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals, matches will be played with the format best of 3 sets (full third set).
- 3.9. All matches are played with Golden Point.
